Approval of Minutes from Previous Meeting (Agenda Item #2)

Public Comments (Agenda Item #3)

- Patricia Bell Hearst commented on the recent CAC meeting regarding the I-405 HOV Project and the communities concerns for support from the elected government representatives. There is concern with the proposed Mulholland and Skirball Bridge reconstruction and moving the on and off ramps.
- Field Representative Ellen Isaacs stated the Assemblyman's Office has continued to work with the community on their concerns at a level of transparency regarding the project.

- President Ringler reported on the success of the West LA Carnival this past weekend that raised almost \$16,000.
- Carol Sidlow announced the 23rd LAPD Hollywood Division Children's Party. She is collecting

 members for their support.

- Carol Sidlow reported on a presentation by concerned residents near a project at 2497 Horseshoe Canyon and the committee voted to continue their opposition to the project.
- The committee supported the RVA's concerns with the possible non-permit grading of 2361
 Nalin Drive. The property abuts Hoag Canyon and the committee voted to send a letter to the
 Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy regarding the preservation of open space at Hoag
 Canyon.
- Carol Sidlow updated on the CPC hearing regarding Code Findings and announced the last workshop this weekend. The Planning Commission will vote on the issue next year in January.
- She reported on the Blueprint for 2010-11 from the Planning Department and copies are available at the BABCNC office.
- Ron Hudson reported on the Bel-Air Bar and Grill hearing and the ZA decision to continue the hearing for 60 days.

Carol Sidlow stated Robin Greenberg is now a member of the Committee.

Public Safety/Disaster Preparedness (Agenda Item #11)

- Chuck Maginnis reported on the outage of Time Warner phone and internet in his area due to a
 blown over telephone pole in Woodland Hills. There were also recent workers counting the
 wires on poles in the Mulholland Corridor, which correlates to the Council's recent motion
 requesting examining poles in the area and the concerns with over loading.
- Chuck Maginnis stated each individual stakeholder could have their own logo on one side of the
 emergency preparedness cards, along with the BABCNC's logo. The efforts could be part of
 Outreach and dependant of the costs for materials. Those interested should email the Council

West Los Angeles Regional Alliance of Councils (Agenda Item #13)

- He reported on the LADOT Mobility Study and parking survey that will be available for everyone in the near future.
- The WRAC committee promoted a Bicycle Plan that will propose bike lanes throughout the West LA area.
- The Wilshire BRT (Bus Rapid Transit) Project is not being supported by the Westwood and Brentwood Community Councils.
- The City is proposing leasing parking structures throughout the City, which include a structure in Westwood, raising the parking fees and have an impact on the community.
