Guest Speaker - I-405 Closure July 16-18 (Agenda Item #3)

- Guest Speaker Olga Arroyo briefed on the I-405 project and the demolition of the Mulholland Bridge. Demolition activities will take place over the July 16-17 weekend for 53 consecutive hours, resulting in the full freeway closure of the I-405 freeway in the Sepulveda Pass. The I-405 freeway closure boundaries for the July 16-17 weekend are: Northbound I-405: 10-mile closure between I-10 and U.S. 101; Southbound I-405: 4-mile closure between U.S. 101 and Getty Center Drive Ramps. On Friday, July 15, ramps along the 10 mile closure will begin to be shut down as early as 7 p.m., and closure of freeway lanes will begin at 10 p.m. to ensure full freeway closure by midnight. The closure will continue until 5 a.m. Monday morning, July 18. Ramps and connectors will be reopened by 6 a.m.
