DRAFT QUESTIONNAIRE, REQUESTED BY SEMEE PARKS FOR THE CITY

Assist the city in gathering information on the ground during the Skirball fire for their "**After Actions**" report drafted after each emergency activation, to include NCs' viewpoints:

What about the City's response worked?

1) LAPD going door to door to evacuate early for the Roscomare area.

What about the City's response didn't work?

1) Slowness of DOT & LAPD to stop WAZE from sending cars down streets being evacuated and slowness of the city to post Officers at those streets sooner.

2) Slow response time to the Bel Air Crest area, per M. Schlenker.

What were the actions taken by NCs and/or board members during the emergency response? What role did they play?

1) Our administrator fielded stakeholder call and provided information, including contact info for HOA and NC rep for their area; forwarded email updates to them regularly as they came in.

2) Our EP Communications chair, Michael Schlenker, contacted ham radio operators in his group, and they communicated with use of ham radios, some of which were purchased by this neighborhood council.

3) EP committee member and EP Communications Chair, M. Schlenker, reported being the only person in Bel Air Crest, who watered down his neighborhood for one hour before Fire Engines

Were there items the NCs purchased for the emergency response? / Did NCs provide human support?

As noted above, the BABCNC previously purchased ham radios which were used during this emergency, and are currently seeking approval of funding expenditure to purchase bush-hydration packs for our local fire stations.
