Dear interested parties,

The [Ridgeline Protection Ordinance](#) has been prepared in response to Council instruction (CF 11-1441-S1) in order to better protect and preserve the City's ridgelines, or the natural crests of the mountains that surround and bisect Los Angeles. The proposed ordinance establishes a new Supplemental Use District (SUD) with two levels of protection that are available to be applied to ridgeline or ridgeline adjacent properties.

Today, the draft of the Ridgeline Protection Ordinance has been released for public review and comment. Please note that this ordinance establishes the regulations contained in the Ridgeline Protection SUD but does *not* propose the application of the SUD anywhere.
