If there are any broadcasting interruptions that prevent the public from observing or hearing the meeting, the meeting will be recessed or adjourned. If members of the public are unable to provide public comment or be heard due to the issues within the Neighborhood Council's control, the meeting will be recessed or adjourned. Public comment is not required to be submitted in advance of the meeting.
