Purpose of Proposed Sidewalk Repair Program:

- o Continue & expand implementation of Safe Sidewalks LA.
- o The proposed Sidewalk Repair Program would repair & upgrade sidewalks and curb ramps in the City of LA.
- o Street tree removals and replacements, along with utility relocations, may be needed.
- The City may adopt policies and/or ordinances to assist in the efficient administration of the proposed Sidewalk Repair Program and its objectives.
- The Draft Environmental Impact Report (Draft EIR) is prepared to analyze and disclose the potential environmental impacts as a result of the proposed Sidewalk Repair Program.
- The Draft EIR and technical studies are now available for public review and comment at: http://sidewalks.lacity.commentinput.com/.
- o Comments can be made during the 60-day Public Review Period December 26, 2019 to February 24, 2020.

 Feasibility report done will be reviewed, they will then do EIR preparation with scoping meetings and public meetings and they will obtain private-public partnerships to help develop and come up with alternatives.

 From Metro's Seasons Greetings Email dated December 20, 2019: The completed Feasibility Study has been received and filed by the Metro Board of Directors. As we have previously shared, in order to allow the Board to consider the full range of alternatives that may enter into the environmental process, from both the Feasibility Study and the procurement for private partners, Metro will wait to seek Board selection of alternatives for this project until Summer 2020. We expect to hold our next round of community meetings in Fall 2020.
