BCA LETTER OF OPPOSITION OF HOTEL

I strongly oppose amending our city's General Plan and changing our zoning designation from a Very Low Residential I and II designation in the Hillsides, to a Commercial Zoning designation, in this case known as "Spot Zoning". It is completely out of character and over-reaching for an area that is designated for Single Family Residences in purely residential zoned neighborhoods, to allow a hotel to be built in the middle of Benedict Canyon.

I stand with Councilmember Paul Koretz in his clear objection to this proposed project that will set a dangerous and permanent precedent, creating a template to convert natural hillsides and residential areas in these hillsides to commercial uses. The outrageous proposal of the General Plan Amendment and Zone change would have an irreversible impact on the community, character of the neighborhoods and the destruction of the environment itself.
