The latter happens with board approval, while the prior requires no action by the board.
  - Conflicts of Interest among BABCNC board members The inquiry came up about how often a board member should contact the City Attorney's Office with suspected conflicts of interest. To clarify, anytime a matter may be on an NC agenda or makes it onto an NC meeting agenda, the board member with the suspected conflict of interest should contact the City Attorney's NC Advice Division every time, even if the same organization has received funding from the NC repeatedly in previous years. As a resource, which will be shared with the rest of the board as well, please visit your February 2021 NC Profile that may help clarify this and other legal issues.
