i. <u>Motion</u>: Motion to approve expenditure of \$250.00 for trees from City Department of Public Works to give away trees and set up an outreach table at annual school fair at Roscomare Valley School <u>Moved</u> by Robin; <u>seconded</u> by Jacqueline; <u>approved by 4/0/0</u>

ii. <u>Motion</u>: Approve expenditure of up to \$300.00 for table (if charged for) and snacks/water for treegiveaway outreach event at Roscomare Valley School. <u>Sunday May 21st</u> – <u>11:00 to 4:00 pm</u> Call and order the trees and pay over the phone or online. We will be a sponsorship for the fair. <u>Moved</u> by Robin; <u>seconded</u> by Jacqueline; <u>approved by 4/0/0</u>

d) Purchase of swag give-away items for outreach events

<u>1) Ask DWP to have a town hall within 6 weeks</u> to show the neighbors what they are doing at Stone Canyon Reservoir at the Overlook or at SWT. Jason Stinnett will give the presentation. If at SWT, will need to give adequate notice. They will need to pay for the mailing to the community. (Gurmet has since contacted us to have only a few members

Nickie related that there was a meeting last night and she is asking for an email blast to ask for a huge showing of people show up at the upcoming Tuesday April 18th, haul route committee at the Building and Safety on Figueroa. She will send us the <u>Save Our Hillsides</u> blast info.

The PLUM Committee passed the HCR for BABCNC & for Laurel Canyon & Bird Streets.

Jacqueline Le Kennedy has been appointed by the Mayor to be the Commissioner of the El Pueblo

<u>Authority</u>. She will be working towards ending homelessness and not have it recur, and towards unity among different racial groups in the area of the Pueblo (between China Town and Olvera Street in DTLA; originally started by former Mayor, Tom Bradley (9 commissioners).
