Public comment is limited to 1 minute per speaker, unless adjusted by the presiding officer of the Board.

If there are any broadcasting interruptions that prevent the public from observing or hearing the meeting, the meeting will be recessed or adjourned. If members of the public are unable to provide public comment or be heard due to the issues within the Neighborhood Council's control, the meeting will be recessed or adjourned. Public comment is not required to be submitted in advance of the meeting.   - Assesses and identifies parcels of land that are appropriate for conservation as determined by trustee agencies such as the California Department of Fish and Wildlife and the Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy;
  - Identifies fully protected species as well as candidate, sensitive, or species of special status as determined by state or federal agencies within these parcels; and
  - Recommends additional measures required to comprehensively conserve and manage the City's natural biological diversity and encourage compatible and appropriate growth and development within these parcels. (Attachment D City Council motion)
