minutes of the earthquake all members were on their CB radios
on Sunday, April 7th from 10-12 there will be a CERT refresher course with a
follow up in May
they have a dedicated line that goes out to all board members
the ham radio operators are tied together

Chair, Police Advisory Board


Chuck Maginnis (Chair, Emergency Preparedness Committee BABCNC)
