I am a parent of a child that attends Wise School, across the street from the AJU campus. I share the community's concerns regarding fire safety, security, smoking, and traffic that have recently come to my attention. As a stakeholder in the outcome of the permit process, I oppose EF's proposal to house 700 and enroll 900-1,200 international students ages 13-26 on the campus. This would be an unacceptable intensification of use and potentially dangerous to my child's safety in the event of an emergency. I would support a local educational or religious use of the property that complies with the existing permit limits of 200 residents and 500 total students.
