Their responses to our neighborhood's concerns have been inadequate in terms of safety considerations for a large population of residents, students, faculty, employees and visitors along the Mulholland corridor. There currently exists several schools and religious institutions and a Cultural Center within just a few miles. The corridor is already heavily populated on a daily basis.
