Below are my notes and comments on the agenda and issues listed above:

Beverly Glen Safety and Speed Improvement Project:

- As noted in the last meeting, the new improvements are being evaluated as we look for issues in need of correction.
- We are also trying to get better LAPD enforcement at Mulholland and Nicada. Kenneth should be working on that as well.
- Since our last meeting, only one person has reached out to our office with concerns about this project. They reached out in response to the posting of this agenda.
- I have also received numerous emails thanking us for the changes and simply asking for more enforcement.
- I will continue to monitor the project, but I would encourage anyone who has issues to reach out to me directly to discuss.

As you know, I am always happy to have those chats.

Wildlife Traffic Deaths:

- I am not aware of any increase in wildlife deaths on our canyon roads, but very happy to look into this.
- Do you have anything you can point to? Any recent news story?
- We could talk about additional signage or other solutions. Just let our office know.

Mulholland Parking:

- Still working with CD4 on this; they are the lead.
- Happy to move on some action items if the committee has something in mind.

AB645:

- LADOT is actively working on this.
- Just last week, the budget committee moved some funds around to fund a program manager position for this program.
