Dear Neighborhood Council,

My husband and I have lived on North Beverly Glen for 7 years. We accepted the traffic knowing that it was a major route between LA and the Valley. What we've been struggling with from day one is the speeding. North Beverly Glen seems not only to be a way to bypass the 405 but a destination for people to race their Ferraris, Porsches, Lamborghinis, souped up Hondas and everything in between. Having cars fly past our house doing well over 60mph is terrifying, especially given that the speed limit only ranges between 20 and 35 mph. On more occasions than I can count we've watched cars pass other cars at tremendously high rates of speed putting countless drivers, school buses and pedestrians in danger. Quite honestly, these cars are just a blur as they fly past. North Beverly Glen is a narrow road with street parking on both sides making speeding cars even more perilous for our neighborhood. Friday night through Sunday night, and really, any night after 9pm if I'm being honest, is a real free for all - speed limits be damned. I can't fully express the distress this has caused our neighborhood. We feel strongly that speed cameras would make our Glen neighborhood safer and less of a destination for people who should be on a racetrack and not North Beverly Glen.

Since we've lived here hundreds of cars have been totaled, sideswiped and at the very least had their side view mirrors shorn off. To my knowledge no one has been killed but it will happen one day soon if people don't slow down.

Also, I've contacted the West LA police dept. to no avail. In 7 years I've only seen one person pulled over on this street. Hard to believe.

Thank you so much for considering our street for speed cameras. It is much appreciated and please let us know if we can do anything to help move this in the right direction.

Let's make North Beverly Glen safe!
