Know all Men By These Presents: That the undersigned, we are severally owners or holders of the land herein after described, or interests therein, or liens thereupon, in consideration of the prospective location and establishment of a public Highway to be constructed over said land, and the benefits expected to accrue to them thereby, do hereby signify their approval of the location of said public highway (to be known as "Mulholland Highway"), and do consent to the establishment thereof over said land, and do hereby grant, convey and release to The City of Los Angeles, the municipal corporation in which said land is located, the perpetual easement and right of way for such public highway over and along said land hereinafter described, lying and being in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, (each of the undersigned who is the owner of any portion of said land, or of any interest therein, granting such right of way as to such portion or such interest, and each of the undersigned who is the holder of a lien upon any part of said land, or any interest therein, releasing such lien as to such part of said land, or interest therein,) said land being a strip two hundred feet in width, lying equally that is to say, one hundred feet, on each side of the center line of said highway, which said center line is described as follows, to-wit: Being a strip of land 200 feet wide- 100 feet either side of ~~the~~ a center line described as follows:-

Beginning in the North line of Section 32, T.1.N.R.14 W.S.B.&M. at a point, 1500 feet Easterly from the N. W. Corner of said Section 32. Thence South 251.46 feet to a curve concave to the right having a radius of 200 feet; thence South westerly along said curve 208.04 feet to a curve concave to the left having a radius of 200 feet; thence South westerly along said curve 220.20 feet to a curve concave to the right having a radius of 500 feet; thence South westerly along said curve 519.24 feet to a curve concave to the left having a radius of 250 feet; thence South westerly along said curve 431.82 feet to a curve concave to the right



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
