- In conformity with the Governor's Executive Order N-29-20 (March 17, 2020) and due to concerns over COVID-19, the Bel Air-Beverly Crest Neighborhood Council Committee meeting will be conducted virtually. - **Public Comment:** The public is welcome to speak. When the Committee considers agenda item “Public Comments,” the public has the right to comment on any matter that is within the Committee’s jurisdiction. Public comment is limited to one minute per speaker unless waived by the presiding officer. Please note, under the Brown Act, the Committee is prevented from acting on a matter that you bring to its attention during the General Public Comment period; however, issues raised by a member of the public may become the subject of a future Board or Committee meeting. The public may signal that they will make public comment by clicking the ‘raise hand’ button via Zoom or by dialing *9 (if joining the meeting via telephone) to ‘raise hand’ when prompted by the presiding officer. Comments from the public on agenda items will be heard only when the respective item is being considered. Comments from the public on other matters not appearing on the agenda that are within the Committee’s jurisdiction will be heard during the General Public Comment period.
